WHAT TO BRING

SUNBLOCK—Summer's in Texas are HOT! If you burn a little, you WILL BURN ALOT here. Be safe and plan on bringing at least one bottle of sunblock with you. Plan on using Waterproof and put it on at least 30 minutes before going outside.

poison ivy protection/Lotion—Wether it's Tecnu or another brand, be sure NOT to leave home without it. The trails WILL have poison ivy on them. Leggings is an option but remember not to run in them twice without having washed them out first. Sometimes you miss spots on legs and arms. Remember that having poison ivy relief lotion can make it much easier on the body.

BUG SPRAY—We'll be out in woods and of course, that means BUGS! Pack a can of OFF or something that can repeal those pesky things away.

BATHING SUIT—Hyatt has a pool! Plus there are places around Austin such as Zilker Park that has a natural spring feed pool that you might enjoy taking a dip in.

COMFORTABLE CLOTHES—Chances are we will not have an early winter so pack something that is lite weight to wear. Most bars and restrauants are very casual on dress code. Of course, don't expect to be welcomed at the ritzer restrauants that have patrons inside wearing tie and slacks. Use your common sense!

SHOES—Besides packing several pair of running shoes (yes, you will be getting them really muddy), you might include comfortable sandals to change into after your hash.

BEACH TOWEL—Having a towel in your bag isn't a bad idea. Besides using the towel to dry off, it can be used to sit on during the evening hours while you watch the performances on stage.

HASH T-SHIRTS—Great opportunity to exchange hash tshirts with hashers from around the country and around the world!

WATER PACK—It will be hot and humid and many hashers are not use to severe heat. Be sure to pack a water bag to take on trail with you. If you have health problems like diabetic, remember to pack something in a ziplock bag to keep on trail with you in case your insulin drops. Sweepers will be on trail but do not count on them carrying extra food or water on them for the hashers.

SUNGLASSES—Yes, your future looks bright so don't forget to bring those shades! Just like your skin, eyes need protection too in the hot Texas sun.

TRANSPORTATION VIA BUS

Barry Bryan (The Body) – Registration – I began hashing in Japan in 1984, with the Tokyo Ladies Hash House Harriettes. After some months I also joined the Tokyo Hash House Harriers. IAH 2001 - Marks to Look for

The following marks will be used on IAH 2001 trail:

- X Check
- Backcheck the trail will branch off somewhere between the backcheck and the original check
- → True trail arrow hashers will always follow this arrow in the direction which it points.
- F False trail. Hashers will return to the last check and search for a different trail.

Be sure to listen to the trail hares at the start of the trail for further instructions. Ask questions if you're confused (which does hoppen from time to time). Austin is HOT in August/ September so be sure to bring a water bottle/water mister on trail with you. The heat will KICK YOUR ASS so be prepared! Avoid heat exhaution, bring water with you on trail!!!

POISON IVY, OAK, AND SUMAC INFORMATION

 Most common allergy in the country claiming half the population

Sensitivity to urushiol can develop at any time

 Solutions or cures are those that annihilate urushiol

 Everyone appears to react slightly different to all the remedies.

The compound leaves of poison-ivy consist of three pointed leaflets; the middle leaflet has a much longer stalk than the two side ones. The leaflet edges can be smooth or toothed but are rarely lobed. The leaves vary greatly in size, from 8 to 55 mm in length. They are reddish when they emerge in the spring, turn green during the summer, and become various shades of yellow, orange or red in the autumn.

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Fact

Poison by is contagious. Rubbing the rashes won't spread poison by to other parts of your body (or to another person). You spread the rash only if urushiol oil the sticky, resinlike sugbstance that casues the rash — has been left on your hands. You can catch poison ivy Direct contact is needed to

simply by being near the plants

release urusiol oil. Stay away from forest fires, direct burning, or anything else that can cause the oil to become airborne such as a lawnmower, trimmer, etc.

Poison sumac has 7 to 13 leaves on a branch, although poison ivy and oak have 3 leaves per cluster.

Don't worry about dead plants

Urushiol oil stays active on any surface, including dead plants, for up to 5 years.

Breaking the blisters releases urushiol oil that can spread

Not true. But your wounds can become infected and you may make the scarring worse. In very extreme cases, excessive fluid may need to be withdrawn by a doctor.

Foreigner's Travel Guide to Austin, Texas
